Camp Director • Chris Kielsmeier Wayne State Head Women's Basketball Coach

Chris Kielsmeier has completed his ninth year as head women's basketball coach at Wayne State College. Kielsmeier is 212-65 in his nine seasons as head coach at Wayne State College (148-46 in the NSIC) and sports an overall mark of 391-109 in 17 seasons as a college head coach with eight conference champion-

ships, nine NCAA tournament appearances and one NCAA Division III national championship (2007-08). With a .783 winning percentage, Kielsmeier ranks third among active Division II head coaches.

Wayne State finished the 2016-17 season at 23-7 overall and 16-6 in the Northern Sun Conference (2nd-NSIC South). It was the sixth time in nine years at WSC that the Wildcats won 20 or more games under Kielsmeier. WSC had two players receive All-NSIC honors as junior center Paige Ballinger was named First Team All-NSIC for a second straight season while junior Maggie Schulte was a Second Team All-NSIC selection for a second consecutive year.



While at WSC, Kielsmeier has led the Wildcats to four NSIC regular season titles, two NSIC Sanford Health Tournament championships, five trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament and one appearance in the Elite Eight after winning the Central Region title in 2012.

The Wildcats recorded the team's most successful season in school history under Kielsmeier in 2011-12, recording a 32-3 overall record while winning the NSIC regular season and tournament titles. WSC hosted the NCAA Division II Central Regional and won all three games to advance to the Elite Eight in San Antonio, Texas for the first time in school history. Kielsmeier was named NSIC and WBCA Central Region Coach of the Year that season.

Under Kielsmeier, the Wildcats have posted unbeaten records at home in Rice Auditorium for three straight seasons (2009-2012). The Wildcats had a 52-game home court win streak that covered 3 1/2 seasons and are 99-9 at home over the last seven seasons, giving Wayne State one of the top home court advantages in the NSIC and Central Region.

Wayne State women's basketball has also excelled in the classroom under Kielsmeier, named to the WBCA Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five of the last seven seasons while posting a team grade point average over 3.40 each season.
