Wayne State Head Women's Basketball Coach

Chris Kielsmeier has completed his 10th year as head women's basketball coach at Wayne State College. Kielsmeier is 237-72 in his 10 years as head coach at Wayne State College (166-50 in the NSIC) and sports an overall mark of 416-116 in 18 seasons as a college head coach with eight conference championships, nine NCAA tournament appearances and one NCAA Division III national championship (2007-08).

With a .782 winning percentage, Kielsmeier ranks eighth among active Division II head coaches.

Wayne State finished the 2017-18 season at 25-7 overall and 18-4 in the Northern Sun Conference (2nd-NSIC South). It was the seventh time in 10 years at WSC that the Wildcats won 20 or more games under Kielsmeier. WSC had three players receive All-NSIC honors as senior center Paige Ballinger was named First Team All-NSIC for a third straight season while junior Maggie Schulte was a First Team All-NSIC selection. Freshman forward Erin Norling was named to the NSIC All-Freshmen Team.

While at WSC, Kielsmeier has led the Wildcats to four NSIC regular season titles, two NSIC Sanford Health Tournament championships, five trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament and one appearance in the Elite Eight after winning the Central Region title in 2012.

The Wildcats recorded the team's most successful season in school history under Kielsmeier in 2011-12, recording a 32-3 overall record while winning the NSIC regular season and tournament titles. WSC hosted the NCAA Division II Central Regional and won all three games to advance to the Elite Eight in San Antonio, Texas for the first time in school history. Kielsmeier was named NSIC and WBCA Central Region Coach of the Year that season.

Under Kielsmeier, the Wildcats have posted unbeaten records at home in Rice Auditorium for three straight seasons (2009-2012). The Wildcats had a 52-game home court win streak that covered 3 1/2 seasons and are 125-13 at home over the last nine seasons, giving Wayne State one of the top home court advantages in the NSIC and Central Region.

Wayne State women's basketball has also excelled in the classroom under Kielsmeier, named to the WBCA Academic Top 25 Honor Roll for five of the last nine seasons while posting a team grade point average over 3.38 each season.
